Please read carefully

- You are required to show the assessor identification to the value of 100 points (see table below)
 - All documents must be original (**certified copies are not acceptable**)
 - You **MUST** use your **current address** and ALL documents must reflect this address
- The documents you show the assessor should be the same documents you present to Australia Post when lodging your application for a high risk license.
- All documents provided must contain your full name, not just your initials. The only exception maybe Council rates notice.

<u>Secondary documents</u> Allowed to use a combination of secondary documents One MUST contain a current photo	Current Australian, State or territory photo/proof of age card (eg NSW RTA issued photo card)	40
	Current Australian Boat Operators Photo License	40
	Current NSW Firearms Photo License	40
	Australian Police or Defence Card (photo)	40
If you want to use credit and savings account cards, these must be from different banks	Current Australian issued NCOC Photo License (post 2006) or High Risk Work License	40
	Motor vehicle registration or insurance	25
	Department of Veterans Affairs card	25
	Centrelink card	25
	Property lease agreement / rates notice	25
If you use more than one utility bill, they must be from different utilities	Home insurance papers	25
	A utility bill (water, rates, gas, telephone)	25
	Bank statement, credit card, savings accounts cards	25
	Medicare card	25

You MUST provide the assessor with evidence of:

- Your name,
- Date of birth,
- Current address
- Signature

Failure to provide the correct identification will result in the termination of the assessment
